5. Duration of personal data storage:

The data stored during data collection will be deleted after expiry of the statutory retention and limitation periods, or after expiry of the intended purpose, whichever is longer.

6. Data subject rights

bielomatik offers its suppliers/service providers the right to access, rectification, data portability and restriction of processing and the right to object to data processing in accordance with Article 6 (1), letters e) and f) of the GDPR. Send your query/request to:

7. Right to object and revoke

You are entitled to revoke your consent to the use of personal data at any time, in whole or in part, with effect for the future pursuant to Article 6 (1) letter a) of the GDPR. In addition, subject to the conditions set out in Art. 21 (1) of the GDPR, you may object the procession in accordance with Article (1) letters e) and f) of the GDPR.
